Everyone is needed to contribute by becoming an association member since everyone will benefit from a new sign that projects an updated, inviting image of our community. Membership is just \$30/year (\$2.50 a month).

The entire neighborhood has now been organized into districts, thanks to Pat Bartoszewicz, Wanda Stewart, and Mary Ogden. District and block captains will assist in distributing newsletters (eliminating over \$250 for postage for each mailing), meeting 8-10 neighbors in their block, and welcoming new residents to the neighborhood. Each of us contributes to the overall appearance of the subdivision. Something as simple as sweeping curbs or painting rusty mailboxes can refresh our curb appeal. Also, be aware that the City Council recently passed an ordinance that will enforce a penalty of **\$50 PER DAY** for parking on the grass.
